WHY MEDIATE?

- •Trademark disputes can be complex
- •Trademark disputes are often business related, subject to business solutions
- Certainty often better than uncertainty
- Legal costs of trademark infringement cases can be high
- •Mediators are not acting as judge or jury, but as facilitators
- Mediation well suited to creative, "out of the box" thinking
- Mediation can incorporate business solutions

TIPS FOR SUCCESSFUL MEDIATION

- •Consider meditation style that best meets your case's needs (facilitative, evaluative, transformative)
- Decide whether subject matter expertise necessary
- •Determine your interests and those of of the other side
- •Understand the dispute BATNA and WATNA
- Do not over state your case
- •Use creativity in developing ways to explain your case
- Engage in interest-based negotiations
