Michael Edenborough (MA (Natural Sciences) (Cantab), DPhil (Biophysics) (Oxon)) practices in all areas of IP law and procedure, in particular patents, trade marks, copyright and designs. He has over 95 reported cases since 2000, of which two thirds were appeals or judicial reviews. He has appeared often before the General Court and Court of Justice (Luxembourg) in appeals from OHIM and Article 267 references (over 40 cases), and in the European Patent Office (Legal and Technical Boards of Appeal). Further, he has acted for the UK Comptroller-General of Patents (in the House of Lords), the UK Registrar of Trade Marks (on appeals from the UK IPO), the UK government (in the Court of Justice), the Institute of Trade Mark Attorneys (in the Court of Appeal) and the Chartered Institute of Patent Attorneys (in the Court of Justice) and the AIPPI UK Group (in the Supreme Court).
