Mr. Tomás Lorenzo Eichenberg is Legal and Policy Affairs Officer in the Industrial Property Unit of DG Internal Market and Services of the European Commission. Mr. Eichenberg is in charge of policies in the area of trade marks and responsible for the review of the trade mark system in Europe.
