



PETRE OHAN, Director of the Department Appeals, Strategy and Marketing Romanian Patent and Trademark Office, RO

Petre Ohan was licensed in Automation as a diplomat engineer by the Bucharest Polytechnic University in 1974. After 12 years of experience as an engineer in telecommunications, he was hired in 1986 as a patent examiner at the Romanian Inventions and Trademarks Office (OSIM).

He has completed a National post-graduate course in Industrial Property (1987), European Patent Academy (1994), GIPA (USPTO 1997 and 2008), IIPTI (KIPO-1999) and OHIM IP Seminar 2007.

Petre Ohan examined patent applications until the end of 1998. During the same period he worked as an associate professor at Polytechnic University of Bucharest. At the end of 1998, he was promoted Director of Appeals and Policy Making Department

His main duties include the Coordination of the Appeals Division acting as Chairman of the OSIM Boards of Appeal (Patent and SPC Boards of Appeal, Trademarks Boards of Appeal & Designs Board of Appeal) and Coordination of the Policy Making Division and is a member of the office group for drafting and amending Romanian industrial property legislation.

Petre Ohan has been a Member of the Romanian delegation with Committee on Development and Intellectual Property (CDIP), WIPO, since 2011; a Member of the Working Group on European Patent Litigation Agreement (EPLA) - EPO, a Lecturer in IP courses and seminars at the national and international level and Editor of the Romanian Review of Industrial Property from 1998.
