Olivier Vrins is partner at Brussels law firm ALTIUS' Intellectual Property department, where he heads the IPR Enforcement practice. He graduated from the University of Louvain-la-Neuve (Lic. Jur.) and obtained an LL.M. in European Law at Ghent University, as well as an LL.M in Intellectual Property and Competition Law at Queen Mary & Westfield College (University of London). As co-editor of the OUP book *Enforcement of Intellectual Property Rights through Border Measures. He has also gained expertise in a broad range of other IPR-related topics, from trademark law to patent law.
